There is some evidence that information intended to produce positive expectations may have a positive effect in terms of reduced pain, most strongly when combined with persuasive communication style and/or a warm and empathic atmosphere. A patient-centered communication style was, in some studies, associated with less pain. A few the studies indicated the impact of individual differences, both in terms of clinicians and patient characteristics. Future studies should develop designs which make it possible to differentiate better between the effects of different elements of communication behaviors on pain perception.
